#### ORDER

On June 20, 2014, Kirksville Water Association ("Kirksville Water") submitted an application for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.<sup>1</sup>

Kirksville Water's application was marked deficient on June 26, 2014. On July 8, 2014, Kirksville Water provided the necessary information to cure the deficiencies and revised its application to correct the calculation of the purchased water adjustment factor to \$0.08.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- 1. Kirksville Water purchases water from Richmond Utilities ("Richmond").
- 2. On July 1, 2014, Richmond increased its volumetric wholesale rate to Kirksville Water from \$2.28203 per 100 cubic feet to \$2.31626 per 100 cubic feet, as well as its Kentucky River Authority ("KRA") withdrawal fee charge from \$0.124 per 100

cubic feet to \$0.134 per 100 cubic feet.<sup>2</sup> Kirksville Water proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective July 1, 2014.

- 3. During the 12 months ending April 30, 2014, Kirksville Water purchased 15,026,401 cubic feet (equivalent to 112,397,472 gallons) of water from Richmond and sold 91,280,860 gallons of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$6,646.17, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.08 per 1,000 gallons.
- 4. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.08 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.
- 5. Kirksville Water's proposed rates, as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered on and after July 1, 2014.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.08 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
- 2. Kirksville Water's proposed rates are approved for water service rendered on and after July 1, 2014.
- 3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Kirksville Water shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
