ORDER

On September 25, 2014, Frankfort Electric and Water Plant Board ("Frankfort Plant Board") moved to file its requests for information to the Intervenors¹ in two stages. Pursuant to the current procedural schedule set forth in the Commission's Order issued on September 17, 2014, all requests for information to the Intervenors are to be filed no later than November 5, 2014, and Intervenors are to file their responses to requests for information no later than November 18, 2014. Frankfort Plant Board requests permission to immediately file one stage of requests for information to the Intervenors. These requests for information are unrelated to Intervenor testimony. After the Intervenors file their Intervenor testimony no later than October 29, 2014, pursuant to the current procedural schedule, Frankfort Plant Board will file another stage of requests for information to the Intervenors.

To support its request to file requests for information to the Intervenors in two stages, Frankfort Plant Board states that it has requests for information for the Intervenors ready to be filed now that do not relate to Intervenor testimony. Frankfort Plant Board wants the Intervenors to have additional time to respond to requests for

information unrelated to the Intervenor testimony. Frankfort Plant Board is concerned that if it is required to wait until after the Intervenors file their testimony, the Intervenors may not have sufficient time to respond to all requests for information and will request that the procedural schedule be extended. Frankfort Plant Board is not requesting that the Intervenors file responses any earlier than November 18, 2014, the date currently set forth in the procedural schedule for the Intervenors to respond to requests for information.

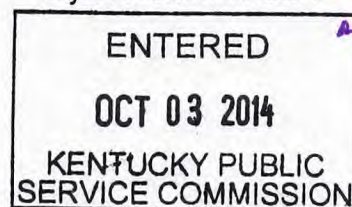
Having considered the motion, the Commission finds that the motion is moot. The current procedural schedule does not prevent Frankfort Plant Board from propounding requests for information in two stages. The procedural schedule set forth in the Commission's Order of September 17, 2014, states that "[a]ll requests for information to an intervenor shall be filed no later than 11/05/2014." The procedural schedule does not prevent issuance of multiple stages of requests for information on Intervenors, provided all stages are propounded no later than November 5, 2014.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Frankfort Plant Board's motion to propound two stages of requests for information on Intervenors is denied as moot, as nothing currently prevents Frankfort Plant Board from propounding multiple stages of requests for information on Intervenors, provided all stages are propounded no later than November 5, 2014.
