## ORDER

On September 15, 2014, Hart County Bank and Trust Company ("Complainant") tendered a formal complaint to the Commission. Complainant asserted that it never received notice from its electric utility provider, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"), regarding a change in rates that made an alternative rate more financially attractive. Complainant states that it therefore paid an unnecessarily higher rate between February 6, 2009, when the new rate schedules were instituted, and May 8, 2014, when it switched rates.

On September 24, 2014, the Commission issued an Order directing KU to either satisfy the complaint or to answer the allegations. On October 6, 2014, KU submitted a joint Answer and Motion to Dismiss. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 5(2), a party shall file a response to a motion no later than seven days from the date of the motion's filing. To date, Complainant has not submitted a response to KU's motion. Accordingly, the Commission finds that Complainant should submit a response within seven days.

Should Complainant fail to submit a response, the motion will stand submitted for a decision.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Complainant shall submit a response to KU's Motion to Dismiss within seven days of the date of this Order.
