MOTION OF BULLITT UTILITIES, INC., FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Comes Bullitt Utilities, Inc. (“Bullitt Utilities”), by counsel and hereby moves the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for an extension of time through Friday, June 5, 2015, to provide the following information and/or make the following filings:

1) The names and titles of each witness to be called to testify at the June 9, 2015, formal hearing. On June 4, 2015, Bullitt Utilities filed its witness list identifying that Chris Cogan, Chris Crumpton and Lawrence Smither will testify at the hearing on behalf of Bullitt Utilities.

2) A list of all documents to be offered by Bullitt Utilities as exhibits at the hearing and the required number of copies of same, where they have not previously been filed with the Commission. The Exhibit List will be filed on June 5, 2015.

3) In accordance with the Commission’s Order of May 22, 2015, file pre-filed testimony of its witnesses. The Pre-Filed Testimony of Christopher G. Cogan and the Pre-Filed Testimony of Chris Crumpton is filed simultaneously with this Motion for Extension of Time.

4) Provide the information set forth in the Commission’s Order of May 28, 2015. On June 4, 2015, Bullitt Utilities filed its Second Supplement to Answers to Commission Staff’s First Information Requests which provided a copy of all promissory notes entered into by Bullitt Utilities as a result of the failure of the Hunters Hollow WWTP. Additional information responsive to the Commission’s May 28, 2015 Order will be filed on June 5, 2015.


5) The undersigned counsel states that the Commission’s Order of May 22, 2015 or the

Commission's Order of May 28, 2015, have not been received in the mail. While this case was not filed as an electronic case, the Commission's May 22, 2015 and May 28, 2015 Orders were sent by electronic mail to the undersigned counsel. Through inadvertence, undersigned counsel did not discover these emails until June 4, 2015. These Orders were apparently not served by U.S. Mail.

6) The granting of Bullitt Utilities's Motion for Extension of Time should not prejudice the parties to this action, as the witnesses that will provide testimony on behalf of Bullitt Utilities in this matter have previously testified concerning the failure of the Hunters Hollow WWTP in Public Service Case No. 2014-00163 and been subject to cross examination in that case¹, the Pre-Filed Testimony of Christopher Cogan and Chris Crumpton basically incorporates by reference statements already in the record in the Amended Application for Surcharge and in the responses to Information Requests, and, the exhibits to be introduced have previously been filed in the record, with the exception of updated bills and correspondence from companies providing services to Bullitt Utilities due to the failure of the Hunters Hollow WWTP.

7. For the above-stated reasons, Bullitt Utilities requests the Commission to grant it an extension of time through June 5, 2015, to file the required information.
