COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO NEW CINGULAR WIRELESS PCS, LLC AND AMERICAN TOWERS, LLC

New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Mobility and American Towers, LLC ("Applicants"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, shall file with the Commission the original and five copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due within 14 days from the date of this request. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry. The Applicants shall make timely amendment to any prior response if they obtain information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which the Applicants fail or refuse to furnish all or part of the requested information, the Applicants shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for the failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When filing a paper containing personal information, the Applicants shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. In accordance with 807 KAR 5:063, Section 1(1)(s), fully describe the Applicants' consideration of alternative locations, including attempts to co-locate on existing structures, in the vicinity of the proposed telecommunications antenna tower.

a. For any alternate locations or existing structures considered, provide the radio frequency analysis performed (including the date) along with any other information supporting the Applicant's contention that (1) there is no more suitable location reasonably available from which adequate service to the area can be provided and (2) there is no reasonably available opportunity to co-locate.

b. If, during the consideration of alternate locations or existing structures, the Applicants communicated with owners, or their representatives, of properties or structures in the vicinity of the proposed facility's location, provide the

c. If no communications occurred with United States Department of Agriculture, US Forest Service, concerning alternate locations for the structure of the communication tower in the vicinity, explain why.
