- (ii) Please provide the methodology that Mr. Rife will use for determining the allocation of costs to B&H and Johnson County ratepayers.

**RESPONSE:**

- (a) Yes, this has been tested by the Public Service Commission's staff, however Respondents do not have these records. B&S recently tested the BTU factor, and those test results are attached to hereto as **EXHIBIT D**.
- (b) No.
- (c) No. B&S operates out of Mr. Rife's home, and he only stored certain records at the building which burned. B&H paid rent to Mr. Rife for office space, but did not own the building. As such, neither B&H, nor Johnson County Gas will "contribute to the expense of obtaining a new building," but will simply pay rent once a building is available. There is no allocation methodology used to allocate costs to rate payers, B&H and Johnson County Gas will each pay rent, as part of overhead operating costs, to Mr. Rife for their use of the building.
