ORDER

The Rural Community Assistance Partnership ("RCAP") has applied for accreditation and approval of its 2016 Rural Community Assistance Partnership water training program scheduled to be held on March 14, 2016, in Morehead, Kentucky, and March 16, 2016, in Maysville, Kentucky.

This Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties."¹ Having reviewed RCAP's application, the Commission finds that the course presentations will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for six hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The presentations scheduled to be held March 14, 2016, in Morehead, Kentucky, and March 16, 2016, in Maysville, Kentucky, are each accredited and approved for water district commissioners to receive a maximum of six credit hours of water district management training.

2. RCAP shall retain a record of all water district commissioners attending the accredited and approved presentations.

3. No later than 60 days after the entry of this Order, RCAP shall file with the Commission:

a. A sworn statement attesting that the accredited instruction was performed:

b. A description of any changes in the presenters or the curriculum that occurred after RCAP's application;

c. The name of each attending water district commissioner, his or her water district, and the number of hours that he or she attended;

d. Documents demonstrating the Kentucky Board of Certification of Water Treatment and Distribution System Operators' approval of the training for continuing education credit.
