ORDER

On October 20, 2016, Nolin Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Nolin R.E.C.C.") filed a notice of intent to file a rate case and to use the Commission's electronic filing procedures. On October 21, 2016, the Commission entered an Order acknowledging receipt of the notice of intent and setting forth certain filing requirements, including the filing of an original and six copies in paper medium, along with an electronic version, of any paper filed in this case. On November 28, 2016, Nolin R.E.C.C. filed a motion to convert the case from electronic filing procedures to traditional paper filing procedures, stating that filing electronically with six paper copies will be more expensive and time consuming than using the traditional paper filing procedures established in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7.


Based on the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the use of electronic filing procedures is voluntary at the election of the person initiating a case with the Commission. Although Nolin R.E.C.C.'s motion includes no explanation of how the use of the electronic filing procedures will be more expensive and time-consuming than the use of traditional paper filing procedures, the Commission finds that at this procedural stage where no application has been filed, only a notice of

intent, no prejudice will result from utilizing paper filing procedures. For this reason the Commission will grant the motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Nolin R.E.C.C.'s motion to utilize paper filing procedures is granted.
2. The Commission's Order entered October 21, 2016, is amended to the extent that from today forward this case shall be processed utilizing paper filing procedures.
3. The style of this case is revised to remove the reference to "Electronic."
