
On behalf of East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”), please find enclosed for filing in the record of the above-referenced case one (1) copy in portable document format on the enclosed CD and two (2) paper copies of the plans, specifications, and drawings of the proposed solar project, pursuant to the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 15(2)(d)(2).

In its July 21, 2016 Application EKPC had requested a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 15(2)(d)(2), stating that the plans, specifications, and drawings of the proposed solar facility were not within EKPC’s custody or control at the time the Application was filed. On August 4, 2016 the Commission granted EKPC’s request for a deviation and directed that the plans, specifications, and drawings of the proposed solar facility were to be filed within ten days of obtaining the documents from Lendlease (US) Public Partnerships, LLC (“Lendlease”).

EKPC would note that these plans, specifications, and drawings are preliminary and a final version will not be received until after EKPC directs Lendlease to proceed, which will occur assuming the Commission approves the requested CPCN.
