APPLICATION

Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") and Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") (jointly, the "Companies"), pursuant to KRS 278.018(6) and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, hereby apply for approval of changes in their certified service territories as agreed with Shelby Energy Cooperative ("Shelby Energy").

1. The full name and mailing address of KU is: Kentucky Utilities Company, One Quality Street, Lexington, Kentucky 40507. KU's mailing address is Kentucky Utilities Company c/o Louisville Gas and Electric Company, 220 West Main Street, Post Office Box 32010, Louisville, Kentucky 40202.

The full name and mailing address of LG&E is: Louisville Gas and Electric Company, Post Office Box 32010, 220 West Main Street, Louisville, Kentucky 40202.

LG&E and KU may be reached by electronic mail at the electronic mail addresses of its counsel set forth below.

2. KU is incorporated in the Commonwealth of Kentucky and the Commonwealth of Virginia and KU attests that it is in good corporate standing in both states. KU was incorporated in Kentucky on August 17, 1912, and in Virginia on November 26, 1991.

LG&E is incorporated in the Commonwealth of Kentucky and LG&E attests that it is in good corporate standing. LG&E was incorporated in Kentucky on July 2, 1913.

3. KU is a public utility, as defined in KRS 278.010(3)(a), engaged in the electric business. KU generates and purchases electricity, and distributes and sells electricity at retail in the following counties in Central, Northern, Southeastern, and Western Kentucky:

4. LG&E is a public utility, as defined in KRS 278.010(3)(a), engaged in the electric and gas business. LG&E generates and purchases electricity, and distributes and sells electricity at retail in Jefferson County and portions of Bullitt, Hardin, Henry, Meade, Oldham, Shelby, Spencer, and Trimble Counties. LG&E also purchases, stores and transports natural gas and distributes and sells natural gas at retail in Jefferson County and portions of Barren, Bullitt, Green, Hardin, Hart, Henry, Larue, Marion, Meade, Metcalfe, Nelson, Oldham, Shelby, Spencer, Trimble, and Washington Counties.

5. Description of Changes in Service Territory: LG&E, KU and Shelby Energy have individually agreed to the requested territorial changes, which for existing customers, reflect their current utility service provider and which service will not change. The territorial boundary changes requested involve two separate parcels of land both located on Fisherville Quadrant 27-E-1. The first includes the Estates of Notting Hill Subdivision in Shelby County Kentucky with service to be provided by LG&E for the entire subdivision. The second includes the Shelby Woods Subdivision, 973 Pounds Lane and a portion of 981 Pounds Lane (Whitaker properties), all residing along the Jefferson County/Shelby County lines with service to be provided by Shelby Energy. This requested change will serve the purposes of KRS 278.016 by avoiding the unnecessary encumbering of the landscape and the duplication of facilities, as well as minimizing disputes between retail electric suppliers. The requested change also corrects territorial lines to reflect existing services and promotes the orderly development of retail electric service. The territorial maps and attachments provided constitute the entire agreement between LG&E, KU and

Shelby Energy.

5. Agreement and Maps: Attached as Application Exhibit 1 of this filing includes the summary list identifying LG&E, KU and Shelby Energy personnel familiar with the specifics of the facilities available, the reason for the change and purposes served under KRS 278.016, and copies of the territorial (quadrant) map, detail map, and agreement signed by all parties for the property involved.

WHEREFORE, the Companies hereby request, pursuant to KRS 278.018, that the Commission enter its order approving the service territory changes and Agreements allocating these electric consumers as agreed to by the parties. Due to the voluminous nature of the maps, LG&E and KU request the Commission to deviate from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7 and permit the Companies to file only two complete set of maps.

LG&E currently provides electric service to all existing lots within Notting Hill.

Shelby will serve lots 1 – 9 on Pounds Lane (Shelby Woods Subdivision) as well as the address at 981 Pounds Lane and a portion of 973 Pounds Lane, all located in Jefferson County Kentucky. Shelby currently provides electric service to each of these Jefferson County lots. LG&E will be responsible for notifying the Public Service Commission of this boundary change.
