ORDER

On October 21, 2010, in Case No. 2010-00116,¹ the Commission approved rates for Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Delta") and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with Delta's Gas Cost Adjustment clause.

On March 24, 2017, Delta filed its proposed Gas Cost Recovery ("GCR") application to be effective April 24, 2017.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Delta's notice includes revised rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in wholesale gas costs.
2. Delta's notice sets out an Expected Gas Cost ("EGC") of \$5.5054 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$1.4048 per Mcf from the previous EGC of \$4.1006 per Mcf.
3. Delta's notice sets out no Refund Adjustment.
4. Delta's notice sets out a current quarter Actual Adjustment ("AA") of \$.8252 per Mcf. Delta's total AA is \$.7094 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.0083 per Mcf from the previous total AA of \$.7177 per Mcf.

5. Delta's notice sets out a current quarter Balance Adjustment ("BA") of \$.0494 per Mcf. Delta's total BA is \$.1031 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.0247 per Mcf from the previous BA of \$.1278 per Mcf.

6. Delta's GCR rate is \$6.3179 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$1.3718 per Mcf from the previous GCR rate of \$4.9461 per Mcf.

7. The rates as proposed by Delta and set forth in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for final meter readings by Delta on and after April 24, 2017.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Delta and set forth in the Appendix to this Order are approved for final meter readings on and after April 24, 2017.

2. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Delta shall file with this Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this Order.
