ORDER

On September 21, 2017, Knox County Utility Commission ("KCUC") filed with the Commission a request for withdrawal of its application for Treated Sewage Adjustment for Sewer Utilities. In support of its request, KCUC notified the Commission that it had become aware that Barbourville Utility Commission, the treatment provider in the application, did not have a tariff on file with the Commission and that the application would be denied as a result. KCUC's request stated that it would reapply for a rate increase once the issue had been resolved.¹

Having reviewed the record and being otherwise advised, the Commission finds that good cause exists to grant KCUC's request to withdraw the application filed on August 28, 2017, this matter should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Knox County Utility Commission's Application for Treated Sewage Adjustment is dismissed without prejudice.
2. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
