Please provide the Commission with an original and two copies of the following requests for information. When the Commission receives your response, it will be included in the case record.



2. Basil Pollitt testified that Southern Kentucky Energy, LLC ("Southern Kentucky"), had an oral agreement to resume using Basil Pollitt's pipeline to transport Southern Kentucky's natural gas between Southern Kentucky's pipeline at the north end of the Pollitt pipeline to Southern Kentucky's pipeline at the south end of the Pollitt pipeline beginning in September 2017. Please explain what plans or agreement Southern Kentucky has regarding future use of Basil Pollitt's pipeline to transport Southern Kentucky's natural gas between Southern Kentucky's northern and southern pipelines.
3. At the hearing, you were requested to provide a copy of the front and back of a cancelled check that represents payment by Southern Kentucky to The Gas Group

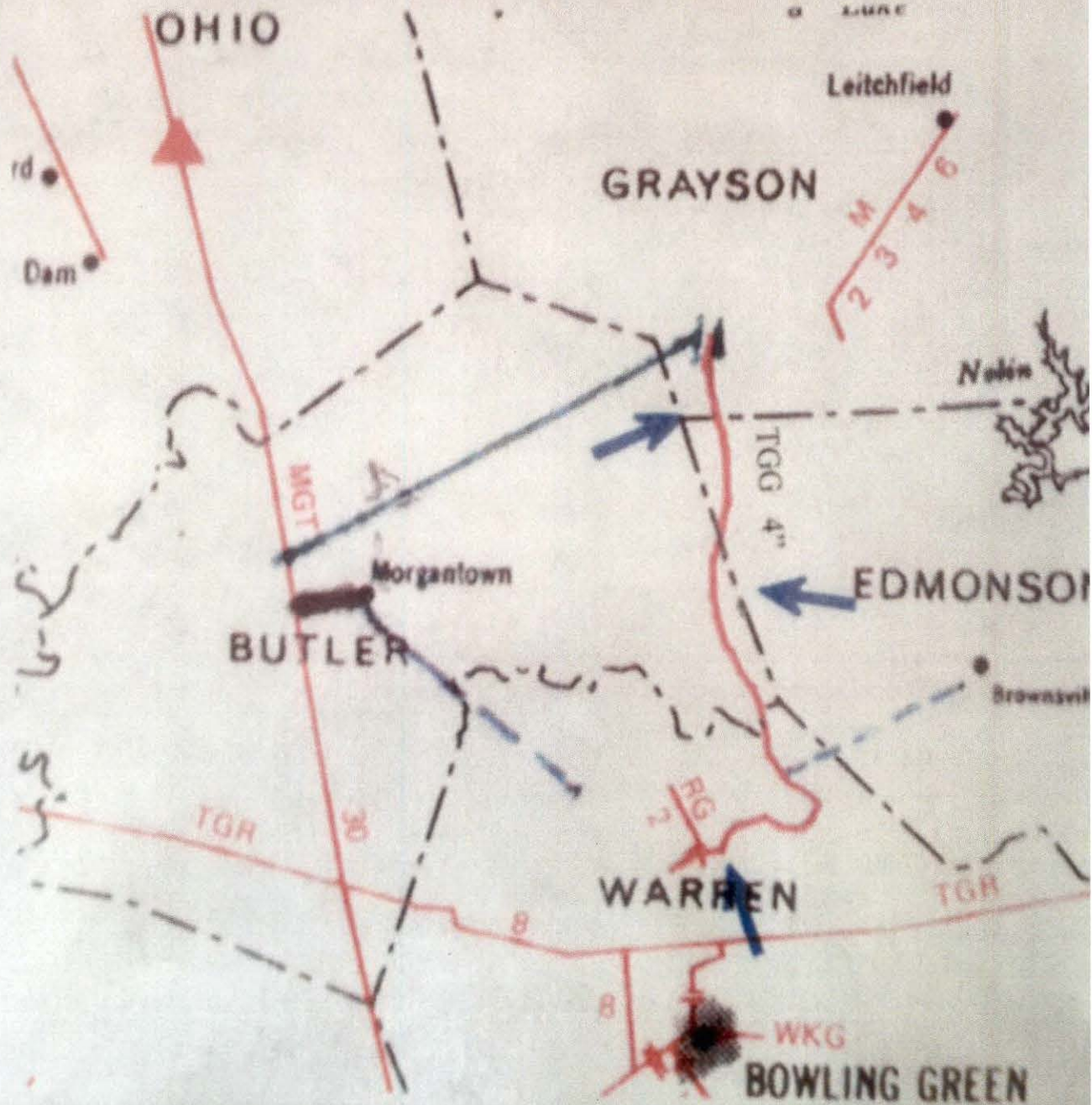
