ORDER

On June 8, 2018, Mountain Water District (“Mountain District”) filed with the Commission revisions to its water and sewer tariffs to revise its connection fee installment payment plans effective July 9, 2018.

Having considered the proposed tariff revisions and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that further proceedings are necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff revisions, that these proceedings cannot be completed prior to July 9, 2018, and that the proposed tariff revisions should be suspended pursuant to KRS 278.190(2).

All requests for intervention should be filed by July 20, 2018. As set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(11)(a), a person requesting permissive intervention in a Commission proceeding is required to demonstrate either (1) a special interest in the proceedings which is not adequately represented in the case, or (2) that the person requesting permissive intervention is likely to present issues or develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. Further, KRS 278.040(2) requires that a person seeking

intervention must have an interest in the rates or service of a utility, as those are the only matters that are subject to the Commission's jurisdiction.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission further finds that any person requesting to intervene in a Commission proceeding must state with specificity the person's special interest that is not adequately represented or the issues and facts the person will present that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter. A mere recitation of the quantity of water consumed or wastewater treated by the movant or a general statement regarding a potential impact of a possible modification of rates will not be deemed sufficient to establish a special interest.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Mountain District's proposed tariff revisions are suspended for five months, from July 9, 2018, to December 8, 2018.
2. Requests for intervention shall be filed no later than July 20, 2018. Any party who submits a motion to intervene after July 20, 2018, and upon a showing of good cause is granted full intervention, shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule, if any.
