<u>ORDER</u>

On April 21, 2021, Corinth Water District (Corinth District) filed a motion for an extension of time to file an application for a rate adjustment that was ordered by the Commission to be filed before March 30, 2021.¹

Corinth District requests an extension to file an application for a rate adjustment on or before November 30, 2021.² For the reasons stated below, the Commission denies this request.

The Commission's March 30, 2020 Order explained the issues raising concern that Corinth District's revenue may not be sufficient to support adequate and reliable service including:

1. The fact that its last rate case was in 2010;

Corinth District's water loss has been consistently in excess of
15 percent; and

3. Questions remain about the veracity of the water loss report numbers.

The fact that the Commission has ordered the filing of a general rate adjustment is evidence of the seriousness with which the Commission approaches this issue. Attached to this Order, as an Appendix, is an analysis of Corinth District's finances prepared by Commission Staff using the annual reports and audit reports submitted to the Commission by Corinth District since 2015. Given that this analysis indicates that Corinth District has reported a negative net income for five of the past six years, the Commission remains concerned that the revenue of Corinth District may not be sufficient for it to continue to meet its statutory obligation to provide adequate and reliable service. For this reason, the Commission finds that Corinth District's motion for an extension of the requirement to file an application for an adjustment in rates is denied.

Despite having a year in which to seek an extension of time, Corinth District filed its motion requesting an extension of time 22 days after the application was due to be filed. The Commission is concerned this lack of attention to important matters may extend to other aspects of Corinth District's management and operation. The Commission expects Corinth District will file for an adjustment in its base rates or file an alternative rate filing on or before November 30, 2021.

For the above stated reasons, the Commission finds that Corinth District's motion for an extension of time in which to file an application for an adjustment in rates should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Corinth District's motion for an extension of time in which to file an application for an adjustment in rates is denied.
