#### **OPENING ORDER**

Prowire Tech, Inc. (Prowire) has been named as a party to an investigation before the Kentucky Public Service Commission (Commission) for allegedly violating the Kentucky Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act (Act).<sup>1</sup>

Pursuant to KRS 278.495(2), the Commission has jurisdiction to regulate the safety of natural gas facilities in Kentucky and to enforce minimum federal pipeline safety standards. Under the Act, the Commission has authority to investigate and assess civil penalties for any violation of the Act that results in excavation damage to an underground facility used to transport natural gas or hazardous liquid subject to federal pipeline safety laws, 49 U.S.C. § 60101, *et seq.* Any person who violates any provision of the Act is subject to assessment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$250 for the first offense, no more than \$1,000 for the second offense within one year, and no more than \$3,000 for the third and any subsequent offense. Additionally, any person whose violation of the Act results in damage to an underground facility containing any flammable, toxic, corrosive,

or hazardous material or results in the release of any flammable, toxic, corrosive, or hazardous material is subject to an additional penalty of up to \$1,000.

Following receipt of a report of excavation damage to its underground gas pipeline from an operator, Commission Staff (Staff) conducted an investigation and prepared an Incident Report, a copy of which is attached to this Order as an Appendix. In its Incident Report, Staff cites Prowire for violation of the following provision of the Act:

KRS 367.4911(10) – When excavation or demolition is necessary within the approximate location of the underground facility, the excavator shall hand-dig or use nonintrusive means to avoid damage to the underground facility.

Based on its review of the Incident Report and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds prima facie evidence that Prowire violated the Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act. The Commission further finds that a formal investigation into the excavation damage incident should be conducted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Prowire shall submit to the Commission, via email sent to <u>PSCED@ky.gov</u> with the case number of this proceeding in the subject line of the message, a written response to the allegations contained in the Staff Incident Report within 20 days of receipt of this Order.

2. Any partnership, corporation, or business entity (including a limited liability company) must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Kentucky, and such representation includes the filing of papers with and appearances at hearings before the Commission.

3. The Staff Incident Report 32349 in the Appendix to this Order is made a part of the record in this case.

4. Please note that notice of a hearing to be held in this matter will be mailed to Prowire once proof of service is received by the Commission. Parties who fail to appear after service will be subject to entry of a default judgment against them.

#### INVESTIGATION

On 09/09/20 the Excavator Prowire Tech's Raul Rodriguez, stated that the incident location was not marked. Mr. Rodriguez stated that the Operator marked up to the permanent gas marker and stopped. Mr. Rodriguez stated that the damage occurred three foot past the permanent gas marker where no temporary markings were placed. Mr. Rodriguez stated that he would attempt to obtain photographs/reports by 09/10/20 from the general contractor Metronet.

On 09/10/20, via two emails, the Operator, Columbia's Ryan Twait, provided the following documents:

- <u>Photographs:</u> Indicating the damage occurred between the permanent marker and temporary markings within the approximate location / "tolerance zone" of 18 inches.
- <u>Damage Prevention Root Cause Analyses:</u> Indicating the damage occurred within in the approximate location / "tolerance zone" of 18 inches of the gas main.
- <u>Invoices</u>: Indicating the Operator billed the Excavator on 01/07/20 and 03/05/20 for the damage totaling \$2,798.67 and no payment has been made.

Mr. Twait's Documents are include as Attachment 3.

On 09/10/20, via email, Metronet's Vice President of Safety & Quality Assurance George Kemp, stated that the main was marked correctly and Prowire's inefficient potholing resulted in this damage. **Mr. Kemp's email is include as Attachment 4.** 

On 09/14, 15, 16 & 17/20 a follow up call to Mr. Rodriguez resulted in a message stating this is Raul, wherein a message was left.

On 09/18/20 Mr. Rodriguez, via voice mail, was informed if no contact is made Prowire Tech will be assessed a penalty

of \$1,250.00.

On 09/21/20 contact was made with Mr. Rodriguez, he stated that he was out of the county, he thought his research in this matter would be complete this afternoon. Mr. Rodriguez was informed of Mr. Kemp's statement and copies of the photographs were emailed to raulrod1981@prowiretech.com for Mr. Rodriguez's review and response.

On 09/23/20 a follow up call to Mr. Rodriguez resulted in a message being left.

On 09/28/20, via email, Mr. Rodriguez stated that Prowire Tech will pay the full penalty payment amount of \$1,250.00. Mr. Rodriguez's email is include as Attachment 5.





I've requested the billing/payment info from our damage collections group, and will forward that to you once they get it to me. Here are the pictures of the damage, and it shows temporary marks leading up to the permanent marker. I am traveling at the moment but I was able to pull up our files and this is what we found for the utility hit in question.

On 12/12/2019 Prowire damaged a 4" Columbia Gas gas main. The damage was caused from a rock that was pushed up into the gas main, damaging it. The gas main was properly marked. If Prowire had done a better job of potholing the gas main they would have been able to avoid this damage. By law and by MetroNet requirements they must effectively pothole each utility to ensure it is safe while they working around it.






