ORDER

Jackson Energy Cooperative (Jackson Energy) is hereby notified that it has been named as a Defendant in a formal complaint filed on June, 28, 2021, a copy of which is attached to this Order.

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 20, Jackson Energy is HEREBY ORDERED to satisfy the matters complained of or file a written answer to the complaint within ten days from the date of entry of this Order.

The Commission directs the parties to the March 16, 2020 and March 24, 2020 Orders in Case No. 2020-00085¹ regarding the filing of physical documents with the Commission. In the March 16, 2020 Order, the Commission stated that if a nonelectronic case is not converted to an electronic case, the Commission will grant a deviation from the filing requirements 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7(1), insofar that a filer may file one

original document with no copies, or send an electronic mail message with an electronic copy of the document to the Commission and to parties to the matter. The Commission expects that original documents will be filed with the Commission within 30 days of the lifting of the current state of emergency. Any electronic email filed in this manner should be sent to PSCED@ky.gov, and each message should include the case number in the subject line of the message and a read receipt to ensure the Commission received the message and documents.² A party filing a paper containing personal information shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

I called him, same day, I relayed to him what I was doing with the cabin, trying to get electric, I told him it was approx. 950 ft from nearest electric pole, that it had an out house to use, he said it should not be a problem, to get it o.k'ed from the Health Dept. I told him I lived on a farm 40 acres, he said once I got the paper from the Health Dept., call him back, and he would come and talk to the carpenter

on April 29, 2021 the Health Dept official came out, and she inspected the cabin, and surrounding area, and I was given a Notice of Release for permanent electrical service, a copy is attached. I pd a check for 25.00 to her Co. Health Dept.

I then called Mr. Fortney building inspector back as instructed to do, He came that same day talked to my Carpenter, ask question of him, he gave some instructions to him, basically to do what the electric Co. wanted done regarding the wiring, and hook-up pole. He charged \$80.00 fee for his inspection.

At that time I called Jackson Energy back, told them I had gotten the Health Dept. release paper, and had a building inspector out, probably 2 or 3 weeks

goes by, then and employees from the electric co. Jason Montgomery ph# 606 872 - 3903 comes out one morning at 7:30 am. I told him I wanted to have the carpetner here to talk to him the first question he ask me was Does the cabin have a septic tank system I told him no, he said it had to, to be considered permanent, He was ready to leave at that point, I told him why don't you come out and look at it, he reluctantly when with me to the cabin, he insisstantly repeated it... had to have a septic system, I told him that I had a release from the Health Dept. if he wanted a copy I would give it to him, after he looked at it, he said he would take it and show it to someone else at the Company and get back with me. A day or two later he called and informed me Jackson Energy would run electric 150 feet that I would be responsible for the rest, he est. it would cost \$20.00 to \$40.00 per foot.

After we ended our conversation, I called him back, and ask him what if I had a septic system installed, he said he would ask someone at the Co. and get back with me, He did a few days later. at that time he informed me it had to

have someone living there permanently, I asked him how many days out of the year? I told him some people live $\frac{1}{2}$ year in one place, move to another the other $\frac{1}{2}$ of a year, they winter in one place summer in another.

Then I ask him what if I wanted to rent it out, would they? he said if I had a water meter, septic system, and advertise it as a business, they would, and that I had to put that in writing and give it to the electric co.

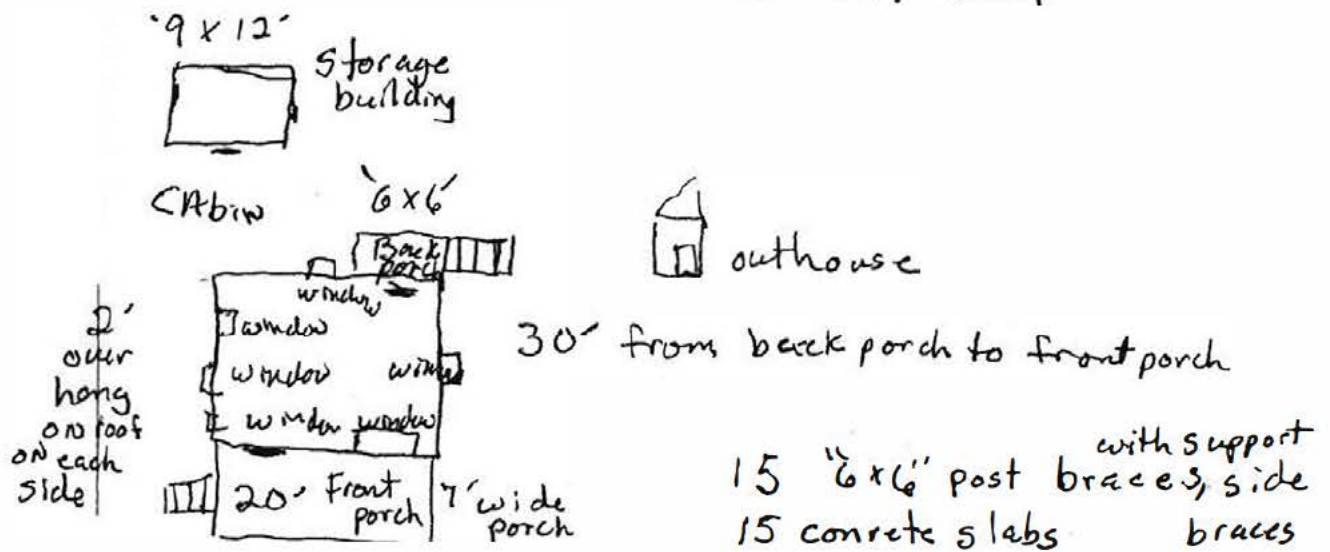

It also has a 12x10 out building for storage. It has a road to it driveable by car. I'm planning on building a carport, it's a great place to live it's not going any place. I want to spend more time there with electric at night, I have ^{appliances} family and friends who very much would like to enjoy it. With all the conveniences of electric brings to life.

Why is the Electric Co. trying to do the Health Dept. job, the building inspector job, he didn't have a problem with it. The

only problem, I have had getting electricity is the company that makes a good, living providing electricity to its customers, which I am, and have been for a long time.
