<u>ORDER</u>

On September 25, 2023, Robert Lee Askew, Jr., tendered a formal complaint with the Commission against Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E), alleging that LG&E refused to provide service to him unless he opened two separate accounts. By Order issued December 8, 2023, the Commission determined that pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 20(4)(a), Mr. Askew had not established a *prima facie* case but was entitled to an opportunity to amend his complaint within 20 days of the date of service of the Order. Mr. Askew has filed no additional pleadings within the 20-day period.

Under 807 KAR 5:001, Section 20(4)(b), "[i]f the complaint is not amended within the time or the extension as the commission, for good cause shown, shall grant, the complaint shall be dismissed." Therefore, Mr. Askew's complaint is dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The complaint is dismissed.
- The case is closed and shall be removed from the Commission's docket.
