INITIATING ORDER FOR ALLEGED 811 VIOLATION OF THE KENTUCKY UNDERGROUND FACILITY DAMAGE PREVENTION ACT

Four Rivers Excavating, LLC (Four Rivers Excavating) has been named as a party to an investigation before the Kentucky Public Service Commission (Commission) for allegedly violating the Kentucky Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act (Act).¹ A hearing in this case shall take place on January 26, 2024.

Pursuant to KRS 278.495(2), the Commission has jurisdiction to regulate the safety of natural gas facilities in Kentucky and to enforce minimum federal pipeline safety standards. Under the Act, the Commission has authority to investigate and assess civil penalties for any violation of the Act that results in excavation damage to an underground facility used to transport natural gas or hazardous liquid subject to federal pipeline safety laws, 49 U.S.C. § 60101, *et seq.* Any person who violates any provision of the Act is subject to assessment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$250 for the first offense, no more than \$1,000 for the second offense within one year, and no more than \$3,000 for

the third and any subsequent offense. Additionally, any person whose violation of the Act results in damage to an underground facility containing any flammable, toxic, corrosive, or hazardous material or results in the release of any flammable, toxic, corrosive, or hazardous material is subject to an additional penalty of up to \$1,000.

Following receipt of a report of excavation damage to its underground gas pipeline from an operator, Commission Staff (Staff) conducted an investigation and prepared an Incident Report, a copy of which is attached to this Order as Appendix A. In its Incident Report, Staff cites Four Rivers Excavating for violation of the following provision of the Act:

KRS 367.4911(10) – When excavation or demolition is necessary within the approximate location of the underground facility, the excavator shall hand-dig or use nonintrusive means to avoid damage to the underground facility.

Based on its review of the Incident Report and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds prima facie evidence that Four Rivers Excavating violated the Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act. The Commission further finds that a formal investigation into the excavation damage incident shall be conducted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Four Rivers Excavating shall submit to the Commission, via email sent to PSCED@ky.gov with the case number of this proceeding in the subject line of the message, a written response to the allegations contained in the Staff Incident Report within 20 days of receipt of this Order.
- 2. Four Rivers Excavating shall appear on January 26, 2024, at 9 a.m. Eastern Standard Time, in the Richard Raff Hearing Room of the Commission's offices at

- 211 Sower Boulevard in Frankfort, Kentucky, for the purpose of presenting evidence concerning the alleged violation of the Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act.
 - 3. The January 26, 2024 hearing shall be conducted via video conferencing.
- 4. Four Rivers Excavating shall attend the hearing by using the following link: https://meet.goto.com/pscformalhearing/psc-damage-prevention-hearing; information and instructions are attached to this Order as Appendix B.
- 5. Four Rivers Excavating shall notify the Commission at least ten days prior to the hearing if Four Rivers Excavating is unable to appear by video conferencing and will therefore appear in person.
- 6. Any partnership, corporation, or business entity (including a limited liability company) must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Kentucky, and such representation includes the filing of papers with and appearances at hearings before the Commission.
- 7. An individual may submit a response to the allegations contained in the Staff Incident Report without the representation of an attorney.
- 8. The Staff Incident Report 54287, attached to this Order as Appendix A, is made a part of the record in this case.
 - 9. The January 26, 2024 hearing shall be recorded by video only.
- 10. Please note parties who fail to appear after service will be subject to entry of a default judgment against them.

LEGAL NOTICE OF GAS LINE DAMAGE

Dear Mr. Gaither:

The Kentucky Public Service Commission (Commission), on January 7, 2022, received the attached Gas Excavation Damage Report (Damage Report) alleging Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. damaged a natural gas facility owned and/or operated by the Atmos Energy Corporation. The Damage Report alleges that on December 8, 2021, Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. violated the Kentucky Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act (Act), KRS 367.4901 through KRS 367.4917 at 330 Wexford Ct. Paducah, KY 42002, by excavating within the tolerance zone of 18-inches.

Under the Act, the Commission has jurisdiction to investigate and assess civil penalties for any violation of the Act that results in excavation damage to underground facilities used to transport gas or hazardous liquid subject to federal pipeline safety laws, 49 U.S.C. secs. 60101 et seq. The Commission regulates the safety of jurisdictional natural gas pipelines in the Commonwealth pursuant to KRS 278.495 and 49 CFR Parts 190, 191, 192 and 195.

KRS 367.4917 provides that a person who commits a violation of the Act shall be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed \$250 for the first violation, \$1,000 for the second violation, and \$3,000 for the third and any subsequent violation. If the violation results in damage to an underground pipeline used to transport gas or hazardous liquid, the violator is subject to an additional civil penalty not to exceed \$1,000 per violation.

Based upon the allegations contained in the Damage Report and the Commission's records of prior underground facility damage, Commission Staff has determined that:

- 1. This incident is the first incident of damage to an underground facility involving Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. within the past 365 days.
- 2. The statutory provision that Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. is alleged to have violated is:

KRS 367.4911(10) When excavation or demolition is necessary within the approximate location of the underground facility, the

excavator shall hand-dig or use nonintrusive means to avoid damage to the underground facility.

3. The civil penalty for this alleged violation is \$1,250.00

RESPONSE REQUIRED FOR RESOLUTION

There are three options you may choose from to resolve this violation. *Please select a method of resolution listed below:*

- 1. <u>Dispute the Alleged Violation:</u> Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. has the right to dispute the allegations made by Atmos Energy Corporation. If you have additional facts or evidence that you wish to provide to dispute the allegations made in the Damage Report, please contact Eric V. Tout, Division of Inspections at 502-782-2622, or ericv.tout@ky.gov prior to paying the civil penalty.
- 2. <u>Penalty Payment</u>: This incident may be resolved by Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. paying the full amount of the civil penalty listed above. *Payment of the penalty will not be considered an admission of willfully violating any provision of the Act.*

If Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. does not wish to dispute the alleged violation, Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. should submit payment, within 30 days of the date of this letter, in the amount of \$1,250.00.

3. <u>Training</u>: If this letter indicates this is Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C.'s first alleged violation of the Act, Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. should contact Andrea Bramblett, at <u>andrea.bramblett@ky.gov</u> or (502) 782-2656 to arrange to attend a training course that if completed will reduce the civil penalty amount due to \$250. Payment of the reduced penalty will not be considered an admission of willfully violating any provision of the Act.

If the excavator would like to pay via electronic payment, please contact Andrea Bramblett, at andrea.bramblett@ky.gov or (502) 782-2656 to have a digital invoice issued. If submitting payment by mail, please send a cashier's check or money order, made payable to **Kentucky State Treasurer**, to the address listed below.

Please include the Incident Number 54287 on the cashier's check or money order submitted for payment or any email request for invoice. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

If Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. does not, **within 30 days** of the date of this letter, pay the proposed civil penalty in full, or complete the course and pay the reduced penalty, or provide the Division of Inspections with additional information that relieves Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. of responsibility for the damage, the Commission will institute an administrative proceeding against Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C..

The Administrative Proceeding will include a formal hearing in front of the Commission, during which Four Rivers Excavating L.L.C. will have the opportunity to present evidence, call witnesses, and cross examine witnesses called by the Division of Inspections. Failure to participate in these proceedings may result in a default judgement against Four Rivers Excavating



L.L.C. for the full amount of the proposed civil penalty. Pursuant to Kentucky law, all business entities, including limited liability companies, must be represented at the administrative proceeding by legal counsel licensed to practice law in Kentucky.



Conforme a la norma KRS 278.495(2), la Comisión tiene jurisdicción para regular la seguridad de las instalaciones de gas natural en Kentucky y para hacer cumplir las normas federales mínimas de seguridad de las tuberías. En virtud de la Ley, la Comisión tiene autoridad para investigar y evaluar las sanciones civiles por cualquier infracción de la Ley que resulte en daños de excavación a una instalación subterránea utilizada para transportar gas natural o líquidos peligrosos sujetos a las leyes federales de seguridad de tuberías, 49 U.S.C. §. 60101 et seq. Toda persona que infrinja cualquier disposición

de la Ley está sujeta a la imposición de una sanción civil por un importe de 250 dólares por la primera infracción, no más de 1,000 dólares por la segunda infracción en el plazo de un año, y no más de 3,000 dólares por la tercera infracción y las siguientes. Además, cualquier persona cuya infracción de la ley provoque daños en una instalación subterránea que contenga cualquier material inflamable, tóxico, corrosivo o peligroso, o que provoque la liberación de cualquier material inflamable, tóxico, corrosivo o peligroso, está sujeta a una sanción adicional de hasta 1,000 dólares.
