ORDER

This issue arises from a complaint filed on August 25, 2025, by Ms. Reda Gray against Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) concerning an issue with tree limb growth around the power lines behind 561 Dover Road, Lexington, Kentucky 40505.

In its September 19, 2025 Order, the Commission found the complaint filed by Ms. Gray did not state fully, clearly and with reasonable certainty an act or omission by KU of which failure to comply is alleged. Nor did Ms. Gray assert a violation of a regulation, Commission Order, tariff, or statute by KU.¹ The Commission further found that Ms. Gray should be afforded the opportunity to amend her complaint within 20 days of the date of service of the Order in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 20(4)(a)(1), and file it with the Commission by U.S. Postal Service mail or by email.²

On September 18, 2025, Ms. Gray submitted additional information to the Commission stating that the power line clearance at 561 Dover Road, Lexington, Kentucky 40505 had been “achieved” by KU.³

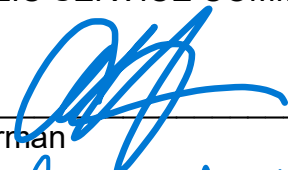
Based on the additional information provided by Ms. Gray, the Commission finds that Ms. Gray’s complaint should be dismissed as satisfied, and the case closed.

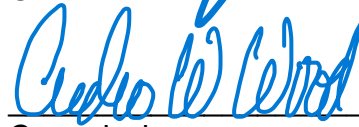
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
