



ORDINANCE NO. 11-09

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MOTOR VEHICLE TAX RATE FOR THE CITY OF MT. WASHINGTON, KENTUCKY FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2012 AND PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mt. Washington, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That for the purpose of support of the government of the City of Mt. Washington, the payment of its debts and expenditures for the calendar year 2012; the City Council hereby levies an ad valorem tax of 11 cents on each \$100.00 of assessed valuation of motor vehicles.

SECTION TWO: That the assessment made by the Finance and Administration Cabinet, Department of Revenue Office of State and County Property Valuation Administrator for 2012 on Motor Vehicles shall be and is hereby accepted as the assessments for City purposes.

SECTION THREE: That of the Motor Vehicle tax shall be collected as provided by law with the Registration and Licensing Authorities of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (County Clerks) collecting such tax and remitting same, as provided by Kentucky Law, to the City of Mt. Washington, Kentucky.

SECTION FOUR: All provisions herein are subject to State law in general and KRS 132.487 in particular, and especially with respect to assessment and collection in the Centralized Tax System for Motor Vehicles established therein. The City certifies that the current tax rate established by this Ordinance does not exceed the rate that could have been levied on motor vehicles by the city on the January 1, 1983 assessments, being the rate of 24 cents on each \$100.00 of assessed valuation per the Governors Office of Local Development.

SECTION SIX: This ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage and publication as required by law.
