Salt River is authorized to sell its Nelson County operations warehouse and the 70 acres on which it is situated as outlined in its application. 3. Should Salt River's final construction and land acquisition costs exceed the estimated cost of \$4 million, Salt River shall, within 45 days of final construction, file with the Commission sufficient information to explain and justify any and all such additional costs. 4. Salt River shall file "as-built" drawings and maps within 60 days of the completion of the construction authorized by this Order. 5. Any documents filed pursuant to ordering paragraphs 3 and 4 shall reference this case number and shall be retained in the utility's general correspondence file. 6. The Executive Director is delegated authority to grant reasonable extensions of time for the filing of any documents required by this Order upon Salt River's showing of good cause for such extension.
