If KU is not the successful bidder, KU shall, within ten days of the award of the franchise at issue, file with the Commission a written notice stating that KU was not the successful bidder. 3. If KU is the successful bidder, KU shall, within ten days of the award of the franchise at issue, file with the Commission a copy of the executed franchise agreement and a statement disclosing the amount of the initial franchise fee. 4. If KU is the successful bidder, KU shall, within ten days of an increase or decrease in the amount of the initial franchise fee set forth in the franchise agreement, file with the Commission documentation setting forth the revised fee. 5. The Commission directs KU to the Commission's March 16, 2020 and March 24, 2020 Orders in Case No. 2020-00085 regarding filings with the Commission. The Commission expects original documents to be filed within 30 days of the lifting of the current state of emergency. 6. Any documents filed pursuant to ordering paragraphs 2, 3, or 4 shall reference number of this case and submitted via the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System. 7. This Order shall not be construed as granting a CPCN to construct utility facilities in said city. 8. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
