Final Order Entered: 1. Kentucky-American is granted a CPCN to proceed with the implementation of cellular AMI meters as set forth in its application. 2. Kentucky-American shall notify the Commission prior to performing any additional construction not expressly authorized by this Order. 3. Any deviation from the approved project shall be undertaken only with prior approval of the Commission. 4. Kentucky-American shall file with the Commission quarterly AMI status reports, commencing with the first full quarter following the date of this Order. These reports shall include detailed schedules regarding capital expenditures, actual cost recovery, and net asset valuation to demonstrate the avoidance of stranded costs and ensure prudent ratepayer investment. The format and content of these reports shall be substantially similar to the AMI installation reports filed by Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company. 5. Kentucky-American shall file with the Commission documentation of the total costs of this project, including the cost of construction and all other capitalized costs (e.g., engineering, legal, and administrative), within 60 days of the date that the project is substantially completed. Construction costs shall be classified into appropriate plant accounts in accordance with the Uniform System of Accounts for water utilities prescribed by the Commission.
