IV. Summary of Comments and Responses:

(1) Subject Matter. 807 KAR 5:110 Board Proceedings

(a) Commenter: Tom FitzGerald (Kentucky Resources Council, Inc.)

Comment: If it is intended that the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting be able to handle cases electronically, and/or to issue Board Orders electronically rather than by first class mail, additional changes need to be made to this regulation. Commenter encourages the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting to adopt provisions comparable to those in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(8)-(11) governing electronic filing and service.

(b) Response: Revisions to 807 KAR 5:110 to set forth a procedural framework for electronic filing and service are beyond the scope of the Board's revisions at this time. The Board has accepted cases to be electronically filed in the past without any objections from the parties to those proceedings. Although this comment may have merit, it deserves more consideration and review by all interested parties.

The Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting has responded to the comments from the public comment period regarding the proposed amendments to 807 KAR 5:110 and will not be amending the administrative regulation.
