The Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") is seeking proposals for all consulting services required to perform a focused review of documentation filed in support of a utility's request for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct transmission lines within Kentucky.

The intent of this Request for Proposal ("RFP") is to solicit consulting services from firms that, if chosen, would be placed on a certified consultant list administered by the Commission. The list of pre-qualified consulting firms will consist of several consulting firms capable of performing the required review. The Commission will select individual firms once a Notice of Intent has been received from a utility. The pre-approved consultant list will be in effect from June 30, 2016, through June 30, 2018.

If your firm is interested in responding to the RFP, please do so by June 15, 2016. It should be noted that the cost of the review will be borne by the utility.
