CHAPTER 31

(S. B. 37)

AN ACT relating to water systems.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section 1. KRS 96.150 is amended to read:

Any city that owns or operates a water supply system may extend the system into, and furnish and sell water to any person within, any territory contiguous to the city that lies within *fifteen* [ten] miles of the corporate limits, and may install within that territory necessary apparatus. For this purpose the city may condemn or otherwise acquire franchises, rights and rights of way, as private corporations may do.

CHAPTER 32

(S. B. 51)

AN ACT relating to boards of waterworks of first class cities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section 1. KRS 96.240 is amended to read:

The mayor shall appoint, subject to the approval of the city legislative body, four persons *no more than two of whom shall be members of the same political party*, who with the mayor as an ex officio member shall constitute a body corporate known as the "Board of Waterworks [.]"; *and if the board of waterworks operates mains and lines and serves in excess of 50,000 customers*
