ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, KENTUCKY, REPEALING AND RE-ENACTING IN AMENDED TEXT AND SUBSTANCE OF PREVIOUS ORDINANCE WITH RESPECT TO SIMPSON COUNTY WATER DISTRICT WATER RATES

WHEREAS, a certain Ordinance of the City of Franklin, Kentucky, relating to rates and charges for the use of the services and facilities of properties now constituting the municipally owned combined and consolidated Water and Sewer System was adopted on June 25, 1990, by the Franklin City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin has determined that the rates were improperly calculated with respect to Simpson County Water District;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Franklin, Kentucky, acting by and through it's City Council as follows:

All provisions of Ordinance No. 610-5C-6-90, as adopted on June 25, 1990 by the City of Franklin are hereby ratified and shall remain in full force and effect if not specifically modified or altered herein. The water rate established in the aforementioned Ordinance shall be amended as it relates to the Simpson County Water District to \$1.68 per one thousand gallons.

If the rate established by this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or found to be in violation of any binding contractual agreement by any Court of competent jurisdiction, then the rate herein established shall be the greatest rate allowed by law. The rate established hereunder shall become effective on May 19, 1991. In the event that the rate cannot become effective on May 19, 1991, because of the decision of any Court of competent jurisdiction or administrative body having jurisdiction over this matter, then the rate shall become effective on the earliest allowable date.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.




