They provide wholesale electric power and services to three distribution cooperative members across 22 counties in Western Kentucky. The member cooperatives are Jackson Purchase Energy Cooperative, Kenergy Corporation, and Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation. The three member-owners of Big Rivers serve more than 120,000 members.



The PSC is an independent agency attached for administrative purposes to the Energy and Environment Cabinet. It regulates more than 1,100 gas, water, sewer, electric and telecommunication utilities operating in Kentucky and has approximately 90 employees.

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
