ORDER

On August 29, 1979 the Commission entered its Order in the above case directing Farmdale Water District (Farmdale) to appear at the Commission's offices September 28, 1979 to show cause why it should not comply with prior Orders of the Commission directing Farmdale to file the following:

- (1) Revised tariff sheets with supporting cost justifications for tap fee charges that are in compliance with Commission rules and regulations
- (2) "Standard Method of Meter and Service Line Installation" pursuant to 807 KAR 25:040 Section 14.4 (now 807 KAR 25:050)
- (3) Revised tariff sheets setting forth <u>all</u> approved rates, charges, rules and regulations of the utility.

Subsequently Farmdale submitted the required tariffs and these were approved by the Commission.

The Commission, having considered the matter and being advised, finds that Farmdale Water District has complied with prior Orders of the Commission as set forth above.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That this case be and it hereby is dismissed.
