On October 25, 1979, Fleming-Mason Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation was ordered to appear before the Energy Regulatory Commission for the purpose of an examination of the Cooperative's application of its fuel adjustment clause for the period May 1, 1979 to October 31, 1979. On November 27, 1979, a public hearing was held at the offices of the Commission in Frankfort, Kentucky. The Consumer Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General was the only intervenor to participate in the public hearing.

The Energy Regulatory Commission of Kentucky is of the opinion from the evidence introduced at the hearing that Fleming-Mason Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation has complied with the provisions of 807 KAR 50:075, Uniform Fuel Adjustment Clause.
