The Commission having considered the filing and being advised hereby ORDERS That this case be and it hereby is set for hearing on the 7th day of April, 1980, at 1:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the Corporation shall at least twenty days prior to the date of hearing mail to each customer a typewritten or printed notice of the proposed rates or charges setting forth the place, date and hour of hearing or publish once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation in the area served by the Corporation a notice setting forth the place, date and hour of hearing and the rates proposed to be charged.
