## ORDER

On May 21, 1980, the Lone Oak Water District, hereinafter referred to as the "Applicant," filed with this Commission its duly verified application seeking a decrease in its water service rates.

The complete record in this matter has been considered by the Commission in the making of this Order.

## TEST PERIOD

The Applicant has proposed, and staff has adopted for use, the twelve (12) months ending December 31, 1979, for the purpose of determining the reasonableness of the proposed rates. proforma adjustments have been included where found fair, just and reasonable.

## REVENUE AND EXPENSES

The Applicant has projected the expenses and revenue for the first year after the current rates granted in Case No. 7349, dated September 12, 1979, have been in effect. During March, 1979, the cost of water purchased from the City of Paducah was increased significantly. Therefore, the Commission granted the Applicant an increase in its water service rates to cover the increase in purchased water and other expenses related to Case No. 7349. During November, 1979, however, the City of Paducah rescinded approximately twenty-five percent of the previous increase to all customers, thereby reducing the rates to the Applicant for purchased water. Therefore, the Applicant is seeking to decrease its water service rates by approximately $5.7 \%$
on the current rate structure for 1,790 customers. The Applicant also has projected that certain operating expenses will increase by seven percent. The Commission is of the opinion that the adjustments are proper and they have been accepted for the purpose of establishing rates. As shown below, the net effect of these adjustments is to decrease net operating income for 1980 by $\$ 16,330$.


## SUMMARY

The Commission, after consideration of all the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion that the rates proposed by the Applicant and set forth in Appendix "A" of this Order are fair, just, and reasonable rates for the Applicant.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the rates set out in Appendix "A," attached hereto and made a part hereof, be and they are hereby approved for services rendered by Lone Oak Water District, effective upon the date of this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Lone Oak Water District file With this commission within thirty (30) days from the effective date of this Order its revised tariff sheets setting forth the water service rates approved herein.
