IT IS ORDERED That Sanitation District No. 1 of Marshall
County, Kentucky shall file an original and five (5) copies
of the following information with the Comission (with a copy to the Attorney General's Consumer Intervention Division) by November 6, 1980:

1. a copy of the bond indenture for the proposed $\$ 70,000$ bond issue. Provide amortization schedule for the bond issue.
2. Provide the caiculatiojns for determinig the annual cash outlay of $\$ 2,500$ for depreciation expense shown in attachment "B" filed September 12, 1980 in response to a previous Commission Order.
3. Provide an estimate of the number of kilowatt hours to be used in operating the lift stations and treatment plant. Who supplies your electricity?
4. How many people are expected to be employed by the utility? How many hours will they spend working for the utility? What hourly rates do you expect to pay?
5. Provide calculations for the $\$ 1,500$ estimated for repairs and maintenance of the existing treatment plant shown in the above mentioned attachment "B".
6. In estimating the expenses for the utility which characteristics of surrounding sewer utilities were taken into consideration in using them as comparisons?
