ORDER

The Commission, having been notified by counsel for South Marshall Water District that notice of the hearing scheduled December 17, 1980 at 10:00 a.m. was published once rather than once a week for three consecutive weeks as ordered by the Commission, hereby ORDERS that the hearing scheduled December 17, 1980 at 10:00 a.m. be and it hereby is rescheduled on January 21, 1981 at 1:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the South Marshall Water District shall at least twenty (20) days prior to the date of hearing mail to each customer a typewritten or printed notice of the proposed rates or charges setting forth the place, date and hour of the hearing. Alternatively, the District shall publish once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation in the areas served by the District a notice setting forth the place, date and hour of hearing and the proposed rates or charges as set forth in the Application. Said notice shall include the following language:

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by South Marshall Water District. However, the Utility Regulatory Commission may, after evidentiary hearings, order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in an increase in rates for consumers other than those included in this notice.
