O R D E R

On March 16, 1981 Kentucky Utilities Company (Company), by counsel, filed its RESPONSE TO ATTORNEY GENERAL'S DISCOVERY REQUESTS. The Response states, among other things, that the Requests would substantially duplicate the information and data which the Company has furnished the Attorney General in these or other Commission proceedings, including data filed March 6, 1981 and additional information and data submitted with the prepared testimony filed March 16, 1981. Accordingly, the Company moves the Commission for leave to withhold further responses pending a hearing and determination as to the objection.

The Commission, having considered the Response, and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that the Company has filed information and prepared testimony relative to these proceedings, that it is available for inspection, and, in the event the Attorney General then determines that additional information is needed, a request may be submitted in accordance with established procedures.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the Motion of Kentucky Utilities Company be and it hereby is sustained to the extent that Kentucky Utilities Company is hereby granted leave to withhold further

responses to the Attorney General's Discovery Requests served
March 9, 1981.
