ORDER

On July 30, 1980, Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (Applicant) filed its Application to flow-through any increase in rates granted its wholesale power supplier, Big Rivers Electric Corporation (Big Rivers) in Case No. 7917.

Applicant is one of four member distribution cooperatives of Big Rivers. In Case No. 7917, Big Rivers requested an increase in revenue of approximately \$29,411,387. Of this total increase, Applicant would experience an increase in power costs of approximately \$1,217,801. This increase represents 4.1% of the proposed Big Rivers increase and would result in an overall increase to Applicant's consumers of 17.5%. Big Rivers also proposed to revise its fuel adjustment clause base and delete its purchased power adjustment clause.

The matter was scheduled for hearing on November 20, 1980, at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky. The hearing was conducted as scheduled and the Consumer Protection Division of the Attorney General's offices was the only intervenor present.

The Commission after review of the evidence of record and being advised is of the opinion and so FINDS:

- (1) That the actual increase granted Big Rivers in Case No. 7917 is \$24,109,533 which will result in an increase in power costs to Applicant of \$1,046,745.
- (2) That Big Rivers fuel adjustment clause was revised and purchased power adjustment clause deleted resulting in a net roll-in of \$363,395 into the wholesale base rate power costs to Applicant.

 The overall change reflected in the base rates to Applicant is \$1,410,140.

- (3) That Applicant is entitled to recover the increased wholesale power costs granted in Case No. 7917 and its financial condition would be materially impaired if it were not allowed to recover this additional cost.
- (4) That the revised rates and charges set out in the attached Appendix "A" are designed to reflect only the increased power costs from Big Rivers, granted in the final order in Case No. 7917.
- (5) That the flow-through of the wholesale power costs will not result in any additional net margin to Applicant.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation is hereby authorized to flow-through the increased power costs resulting from the rate increase granted its wholesale power supplier in Case No. 7971.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the rates set out in Appendix
"A" shall be placed into effect simultaneously with the effective
date of the Big Rivers wholesale power increase.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation shall file within twenty (20) days from the date of this Order its revised tariff sheets setting out the rates and charges approved herein.
