
On February 24, 1981, the University of Kentucky Student Association, by counsel, filed its Motion requesting an extension of time to file testimony. As grounds for the Motion, it is stated that General Telephone Company of Kentucky has failed to supply information requested by the Attorney General and that this information is necessary in order to prepare testimony.

By Order entered February 25, 1981, the Commission directed General Telephone Company of Kentucky to submit by March 4, 1981 responses to interrogatories and document requests of the Attorney General with the exception of those relating to cost studies, briefs having been requested on this aspect.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, hereby ORDERS that said Motion be and it hereby is sustained, and the time within which the University of Kentucky Student Association shall file its testimony in verified prepared form be and it hereby is extended to and including March 11, 1981.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That all Requests for Information to the University of Kentucky Student Association shall be submitted. on or before March 16, 1981, with copies to parties of record, and, further, that Intervenors shall file Responses to Requests for Information on or before March 23, 1981, with copies to parties of record.
