ORDER

IT IS ORDERED That Charleswood Sewage Treatment Plant shall file an original and twelve (12) copies of the following information with the Commission by March 24, 1981.

> 1. Provide a copy of the following information: Contracts for managers services Bill for sludge hauling during the test period Electricity bills for the test period Water bills for the test period Amortization for long-term debt showing principal and interest separately Invoices for the repair and maintenance work performed during the test period.

- 2. Provide a breakdown of the total charges from Butler Construction Company for the test period ending August 31, 1980.
- 3. Provide a breakdown of taxes other than income of \$4,476.
- 4. Provide the computations used to determine the operation labor expense of \$19,828.
- 5. Explain the rise in office expense from \$0 in 1979 to \$1,275 by the end of the test period, August 31, 1980.
- 6. Provide an explanation of the services rendered to the utility for the legal and accounting fees paid by the utility.
- 7. Provide an explanation of the basis for and the computations used to determine the increased cost in chemicals.
- 8. Are the current rate case expenses included in the proposed operating expenses of the utility, if so, provide a breakdown of these expenses and where they were included in the operating expenses.
- 9. How often must sludge be hauled during a normal twelve (12) month operation?
- 10. How much money is estimated to be saved by charging a flat rate for sewage services as opposed to basing rates on water usage?

What percentage of your customers (approximately) would experience a higher sewer bill as a result of a flat rate? What is the approximate amount of additional revenue?

11. Who owns the forty shares of common stock outstanding?
