O R D E R

On May 12, 1981, Sanico, Inc., (Sanico), by counsel, filed its Motion to Accept Continuation of Existing Third Party Agreement, or to Waive Requirement of Third Party Agreement. The motion states that the Bank of Maysville, the representative under the original Third Party Agreement, has informed Sanico that it is unwilling to enter into an agreement imposing a duty upon the Bank to take over the operations of Sanico in the event of a default. The motion further states that the treatment plant of Sanico will be closed this summer and that sewage will be transferred to the City of Maysville for treatment; therefore, the sole obligation in the event of default would be the maintenance of the collection facilities.

The Commission, having considered the motion and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that in view of the peculiar circumstances set forth above, the existing Third Party Agreement between Sanico and the Bank of Maysville should be deemed to be in compliance with 807 KAR 5:071E(2)(a).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the motion of Sanico to accept the existing Third Party Agreement be and it hereby is sustained.
