ORDER

On February 2, 1981, the Energy Regulatory Commission received a letter from Hickman Fulton Counties Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation which sought approval from the Energy Regulatory Commission to utilize Electric Sales Engineering Company, Bowling Green, Kentucky for testing of its meters.

The Energy Regulatory Commission having considered the request and being advised is of the opinion and FINDS:

- 1. That in accordance with 807 KAR 50:015, Section 13, Paragraph 2, a utility may have all or part of its testing of meters performed by another utility or agency which has been approved by the Commission for this purpose.
- 2. That the proposed testing arrangement is in the public interest and should be approved.

The Energy Regulatory Commission further finds that the approval of the proposed arrangement does not relieve the utility from the responsibility of insuring that all tests of meters and measuring devices are performed in accordance with the requirements of the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Hickman Fulton Counties Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation be and it is hereby granted approval to utilize the services of Electric Sales Engineering Company, Bowling Green, Kentucky, for the testing of its meters.
