erative, Corporation shall file an original and five copies of the following information with this Commission, with a copy to the Attorney General's Division of Consumer Intervention, by June 4, 1981. Where a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), page 2 of 5. Careful attention should be given to copied material to insure that it is legible.

- 1. The detailed work papers showing calculations supporting the following adjustments:
 - I. Salaries and wages
 - II. Fringe benefits
 - III. Depreciation

Include a detailed narrative explanation of each adjustment and the reason why each adjustment is required. Explain all components used in each calculation and index each calculation to the adjustment which it supports.

- 2. A schedule of salaries and wages for the test year and each of the five calendar years preceding the test year as shown in Format 1. attached.
- 3. A detailed analysis of advertising expenditures during the test period. This analysis should include a breakdown of Account 913 Advertising Expenses, as shown in Format 2, attached and should also show any advertising expenditures included in other expense accounts. The analysis should be specific as to the purpose and expected benefit of each expenditure.
- 4. An analysis of Account 930 Miscellaneous General Expenses, for the test period. This should include a complete breakdown of this account as shown in attached Format 3, and also provide all detailed working papers supporting this analysis. At minimum, the work papers should show the date, vendor, reference (i.e., voucher no., etc.), dollar amount, and brief description of each expenditure. Exclude items less than \$50 from detailed analysis.
- 5. A detailed analysis of contributions for charitable and political purposes (in cash or services). This analysis should indicate the amount of the expenditure, the recipient of the contribution, and the specific account charged.
- 6. A copy of the auditor's report from your most recent audit.
- 7. A statement of electric plant in service, per company books for the test year, as shown in Format 4, attached.
- 8. Provide the utility's times interest earned ratio and debt service coverage ratio, as calculated by the Rural Electrification Administration, for the test year and the five preceding

calendar years. Include the data used to calculate each ratio.

- 9. Provide details of the utility's policies regarding assignment, accumulation, and disbursement of patronage capital.
- 10. Provide work papers showing how the 3.1% depreciation rate for distribution plant was determined.
