NOTICE OF HENDERSON-UNION RURAL
ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION

THAT ON THE 1ST DAY OF MAY, 1981, IT WILL ADJUST ITS
RATES TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE REVENUES FOR ITS OPERATIONS
AND WILL CHANGE ENERGY REQUIREMENT IN TWO CATAGORIES
OF SERVICE AND IN THE MANNER OF BILLING FOR SECURITY
LAMPS AND STREET LIGHTS

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED That the above case be and it hereby is set for
hearing on July 30, 1981, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in
the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Henderson-Union Rural Electric
Cooperative Corporation shall at least 20 days prior to the date of
hearing mail to each customer a typewritten or printed notice of the
proposed rates or charges setting forth the place, date and hour of
the hearing. Alternatively, the Company shall publish once a week
for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper or newspapers of general
circulation in the areas served by the Company a notice setting forth
the place, date and hour of hearing and the proposed rates or charges
as set forth in the application. Said notice shall include the
following language:

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Henderson-Union Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation. However, the Public Service Commission may, after evidentiary hearings, order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in an increase in rates for consumers other than those included in this notice.
