O R D E R

On April 28, 1981, Capitol Communications of Kentucky Associates ("Capitol Communications") filed with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") a proposed tariff sheet to be effective May 4, 1981, reducing its rates as follows:

	<u>From</u> (per mo. per unit)	<u>To</u> (per mo. per unit)
Rental of selective calling pocket receiver (tone-only)	\$10.00	\$ 8.00
Rental of dual address pocket receiver (tone-only)	12.00	10.00
Service of selective calling pocket receiver (tone-only)	12.00	10.00

The utility further requested that the statutory notice period be waived.

The Commission, having reviewed the tariff filing and being sufficiently advised, finds that the proposed rates are fair, just and reasonable and there is no reason why this utility's customers should be required to wait 20 days before receiving the benefit of this reduction.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Capitol Communication's U.R.C. No. 1, Revised Page 11, be and it is hereby approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the statutory notice period is waived pursuant to KRS 278.180(2), and the tariff filing herein approved shall become effective for services rendered on and after May 4, 1981.
