## ORDER

On June 1, 1981, South Central Bell Telephone Company, ("Company"), by counsel, filed its motion requesting that the Commission direct the Company and Logan Telephone Cooperative, Inc., ("Cooperative"), to each choose a licensed survey engineer and have the two engineers select a third licensed survey engineer acceptable to both for the purpose of surveying the exchange boundary lines and the buildings to be constructed by Anaconda Aluminum Company in Logan County near Lewisburg, Kentucky. The Company also requests that a conference be scheduled between the parties and the Commission Staff after receipt of the survey report in order to discuss and resolve the dispute. Finally, the motion requests that the Commission direct each party to pay the cost of its survey and one-half of the fee charged by the third survey engineer.

The Commission, having considered the motion and being advised, finds that:

- While a survey of the exchange boundaries and the buildings to be constructed by Anaconda Aluminum Company may be useful in the ultimate disposition of this matter, this case should be set for hearing for the purpose of receiving testimony from the Company and the Cooperative concerning the provision of service.
- 2. The Company and the Cooperative should conduct a joint survey of the exchange boundaries and buildings to be constructed and submit the results to the Commission prior to the hearing, the arrangements and methods for conducting the survey to be determined by the utilities.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the motion of the Company be and it hereby is sustained only to the extent that the Company and the Cooperative are hereby directed to conduct a joint survey of the exchange boundary lines and the facilities to be constructed by Anaconda Aluminum Company, the arrangements and methods for conducting the survey to be determined by the utilities.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That this case be and it hereby is set for hearing on July 7, 1981, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.
