## PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE ORDER

Pursuant to its Order dated December 22, 1981, the Commission held a pre-hearing conference in the above matter which was attended by representatives of the attached list of companies. - 4. The evidentiary hearing will be held as originally scheduled beginning on February 2, 1982.
- 5. The utilities will present their witnesses on February 2 and February 3, 1982, and the cable television companies will present their witnesses beginning on Thursday, February 4, 1982.
