On February 8, 1982 Governor Brown signed an executive order placing in immediate effect an ammendment to KAR 5:006E, Section 11 concerning discontinuance of service by electric and gas utilities. On February 8, 1982 the amended regulation was submitted to the Legislative Research Commission (Administrative Regulations) for consideration.

The Commission, having considered the matter and being advised HEREBY ORDERS That this case be and it hereby is set for hearing on April 21, 1982, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, in the Commission's offices, at Frankfort, Kentucky, for the purpose of receiving testimony relative to this matter.
