# ORDER

On March 29, 1974, the Commission issued its order in Case No. 5988, approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased.

On March 22, 1982, Pendleton County Water District, Gas Division ("Pendleton") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be decreased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective March 1, 1982, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with this Commission's order of March 29, 1974. The notice set out certain revisions in rates which Pendleton proposed to place in effect, said rates being designed to decrease the cost of natural gas of its supplier in the amount of \$5,931.

After reviewing this evidence of record and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:



1. Pendleton's supplier, Transmission, on March 16, 1982, filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") for decreased rates to become effective March 1, 1982, and that the decrease sought by Pendleton reflects Transmission's rates so filed.

2. Pendleton's adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment clause approved by the Commission in its order in Case No. 5988, dated March 29, 1974, is fair, just and reasonable, in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after the date the decreased cost of wholesale gas becomes effective.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that said purchased gas adjustment sought by Pendleton and adjusted as previouslymentioned be and is hereby approved, to be effective, with gas supplied on and after the date the decreased cost of wholesale gas becomes effective ("acceptance" by FERC).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for the purpose of the future application of the purchased gas adjustment clause of Pendleton the base rate for purchased gas shall be:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the information furnished this Commission by Pendleton on March 22, 1982, constitutes full compliance with the Commission's order in Case No. 5988, and any other information ordinarily required to be filed under the Commission's Regulations is hereby waived.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days after the date the decreased cost of gas becomes effective, Pendleton shall file with this Commission its revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein.
