O R D E R

On December 30, 1981, Johnson County Water District ("Johnson County") filed its application with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking authority to adjust its rates for service. The increase sought is the result of an increase in the cost of wholesale water purchased from the City of Paintsville. Johnson County further requested approval of revised rules and regulations for the provision of service, increases in special service charges and tap-on fees, and establishment of monthly fire protection rates.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) As part of its tariff, Johnson County should file a purchased water adjustment clause that is in compliance with 807 KAR 5:067, Purchased Water Adjustment Clause. Appendix B contains a sample purchased water adjustment tariff which is acceptable to the Commission.

(2) Johnson County's supplier, City of Paintsville, increased the wholesale cost of water effective January 1, 1980.

(3) Johnson County is no longer able to absorb the increased cost of the wholesale water.

(4) In calculating its purchased water adjustment, Johnson County computed its water costs based on an average monthly usage arrived at after making adjustments for the maximum 15 percent line loss. The difference in water costs, based on the average monthly usage at the old and new rates, was then annualized to arrive at a total allowable increase of \$27,751 or \$.60 per 1,000 gallons. This calculation is incorrect inasmuch as the purchased water costs are to be based on actual gallons, plus the maximum 15 percent line loss allowance, rather than average gallons. The corrected purchased water adjustment allows a total increase of \$26,658 or \$.58 per 1,000 gallons.

(5) The base rate for purchased water for future application of the purchased water adjustment clause should be:

(6) The rates in Appendix A are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved.

(7) The Commission will require additional information to determine the reasonableness of the revised rules and regulations, including the proposed monthly rates for fire protection services and increased service charges. These issues are not related to the purchased water adjustment and should be considered separately in a different proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, as part of its tariff, Johnson County shall file a purchased water adjustment clause that is in compliance with 807 KAR 5:067, Purchased Water Adjustment Clause.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the purchased water adjustment of \$.58 per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A be and they hereby are approved, effective with water supplied on and after the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for the purpose of future application of the purchased water adjustment clause of Johnson County, the base rate for purchased water shall be:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the reasonableness of the revised rules and regulations, the proposed fire protection rates and increased service charges shall be considered separately and that cost information justifying the fire protection rates, appropriate notification of customers affected thereby and such other information as may be required shall be filed by Johnson County as a part of Case No. 8473.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order, Johnson County shall file with the Commission its revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein.
