MOTION TO ADJUST RATES IN ACCORDANCE WITH PURCHASED GAS ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE OF MARTIN GAS COMPANY, INC.

CASE NO. 7156-U

### ORDER

On December 20, 1978, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 7156 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased.

On August 9, 1982, Martin Gas, Inc., ("Martin") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be increased by its supplier, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., ("Columbia") effective September 1, 1982, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with this Commission's Order of December 20, 1978. The notice set out certain revisions in rates which Martin proposed to place in effect, said rates being designed to recover the increased cost of natural gas from its supplier in the amount of \$53,523.

After reviewing this evidence of record and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Martin's supplier has filed for increased rates
and said rates will become effective on and after September 1,
1982.

(2) Martin's adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment clause approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 7156, dated December 20, 1978, is fair, just and reasonable and in the public interest and should be allowed to be effective with gas supplied on and after September 1, 1982, subject to refund.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the purchased gas adjustment sought by Martin be and it hereby is authorized to be effective with gas supplied on and after September 1, 1982, subject to refund, as in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Martin shall maintain its records in such manner as will enable it, or the Commission, or any of its customers to determine the amount to be refunded and to whom due in the event a refund is ordered by the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for the purpose of the future application of the purhcased gas adjustment clause of Martin the base rate for purchased gas shall be:



# APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 7156-U DATED SEPTEMBER 9, 1982

The following rates are prescribed for the customers in the area served by Martin Gas Company, Inc. All other rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of the Commission prior to the date of this Order.

RATES: Monthly

First	2	Mcf	\$5.7509 per	Mcf
Over	2	Mcf	6.5509 per	Mcf

Minimum Bill

The minimum bill shall be \$5.50, which entitles the user to less than 2 Mcf per month.
